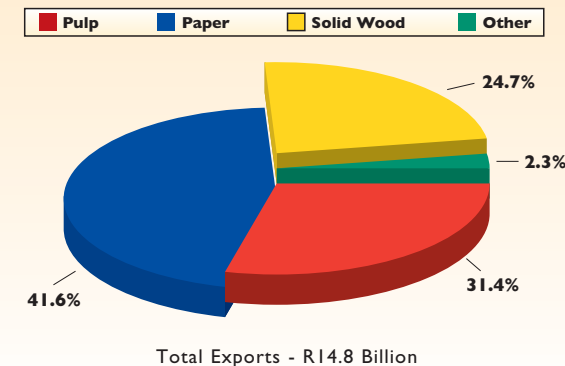

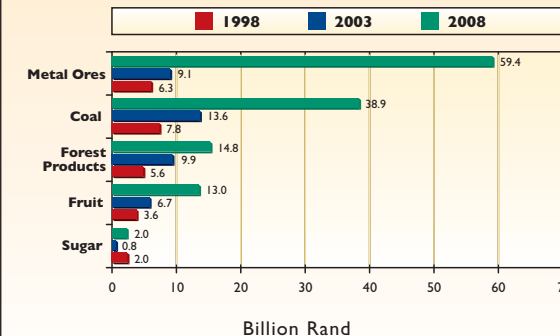

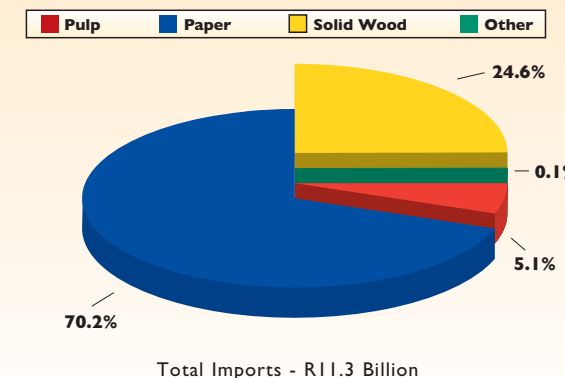
Forest Product Exports 2008



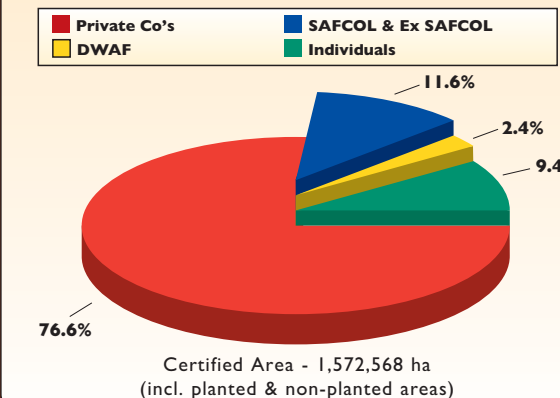
Export Comparisons 1998, 2003 & 2008



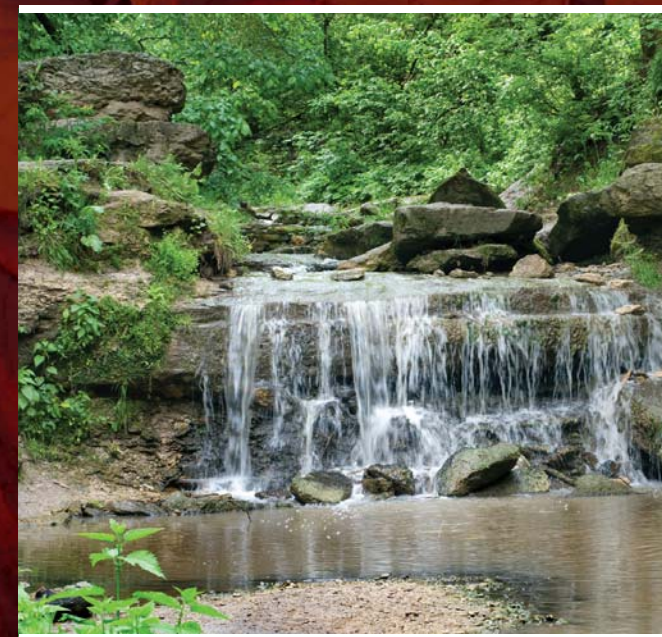
Forest Product Imports 2008

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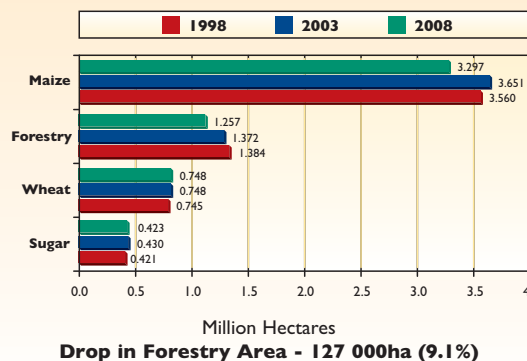

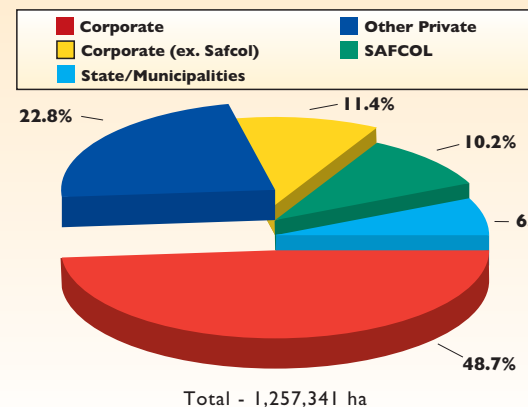

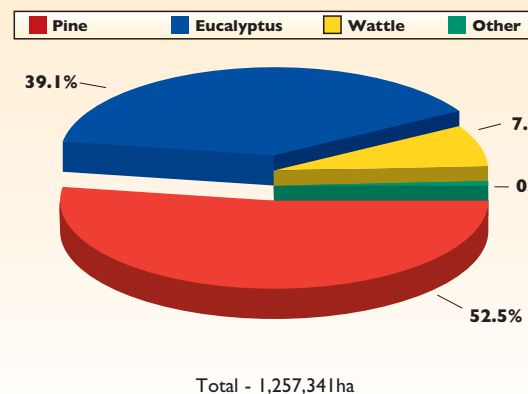

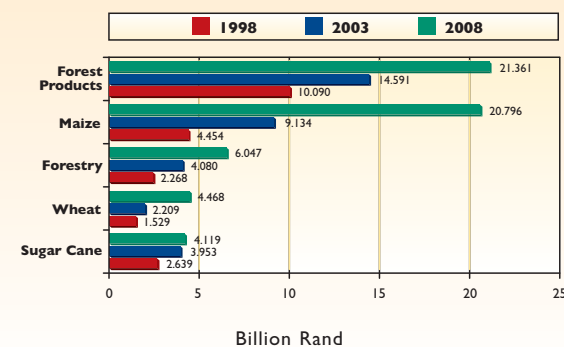

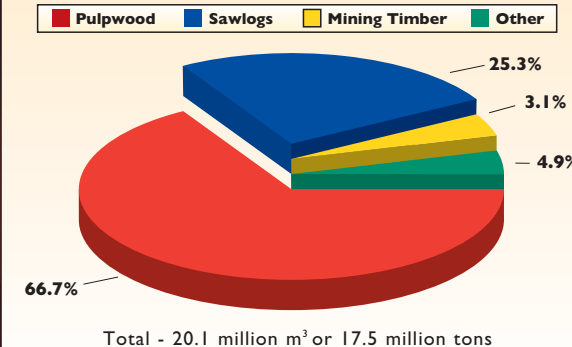

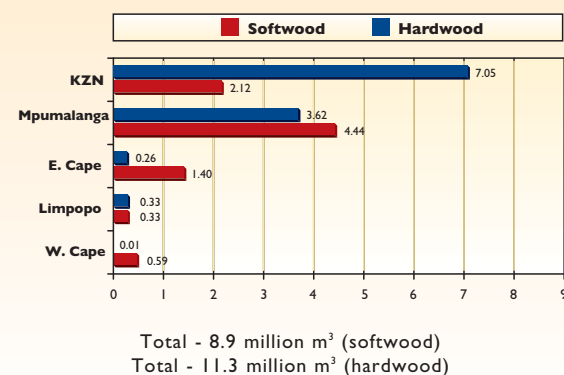
Gross Value of Output Comparisons 1998, 2003 & 2008
